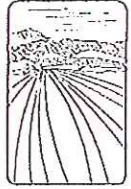

OREGON AND WASHINGTON

GRAPE COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT

Oregon's Grape Quarantine (OAR 603-052-0051) regulates the movement of grape plants and fruit into the state of Oregon from all other states. The quarantine requires each shipment of fruit to be accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate attesting that the shipment is free from harmful pests and diseases. This compliance agreement is put into place to allow Washington grape growers to ship their fruit into Oregon without a phytosanitary certificate accompanying each shipment as required by Oregon's Grape Quarantine.


This approval is made subject to compliance with the following requirements:

1. This agreement authorizes the importation of table and wine grapes grown in the state of Washington into Oregon without the grapes being accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate. A phytosanitary certificate must accompany all other shipments of plant parts of grape (*Vitis* species), including plants and cuttings.
2. WSDA may authorize grape growers to ship under this agreement only from areas known to be free of harmful pest and diseases, in particular vine mealybug (*Planococcus ficus*) and European grapevine moth (*Lobesia botrana*).
3. WSDA shall provide the ODA with the methodology and results of recent detection surveys for vine mealybug and European grapevine moth.
4. Cull or immature fruit of table or wine grapes are not permitted to be imported into Oregon under this agreement.
5. WSDA shall provide the ODA with a list of growers and their addresses authorized to ship under this compliance agreement.
6. The material imported under this agreement shall meet all other applicable state and federal regulatory requirements.

Noncompliance with the requirements stated above may result in either suspension or revocation of this agreement. Otherwise, this agreement shall remain in force until revoked by either the Oregon Department of agriculture or by the Washington State Department of Agriculture. Revisions may be made as necessary to include, delete, or modify requirements.
