

Following is the preliminary report on prices per ton for grapes at the region and state levels from the 2022 Oregon Vineyard and Winery Report. Data reflect sales to third parties only and do not account for related-party transactions.

The average price per ton decreased by \$164 (-6%) while the median price per ton increased by \$142 (+6%) when comparing the state figures to 2021. The three highest median prices were for Chardonnay (\$2,861), Gamay (\$2,810), Pinot Noir (\$2,712). The lowest three median prices were for Gewürztraminer (\$1,535), Riesling (\$1,691), and Pinot Gris (\$1,663).

The University of Oregon research team began collecting AVA data for growers for the 2021 vintage. That effort was continued in 2022 and the team was able to develop estimates for all production for many AVAs, and by variety for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The main limiting factor in AVA-level estimates is having enough data to develop the estimates.

The three highest median prices by AVA were Dundee Hills (\$3,500), Eola-Amity-Hills (3,014), Laurelwood District (\$2,971).
