

BACKGROUND

Wines from volcanic soils have captured the attention of US wine media and industry professionals in recent years. The award winning book, Volcanic Wines: Salt, Grit and Power, by Master Sommelier John Szabo, has spurred interest in these unique terroirs, and has been a catalyst in creating a volcanic wine category in its own right. Volcanic wines have featured recently in countless influential publications, including the New York Times, The Guardian, Decanter, Wine & Spirits Magazine, The Drinks Business, Gault Millau, and JancisRobinson.com, among others... further evidence of this emerging category, while sommeliers have embraced their distinctive characters, and in some cases have created a separate section for them on cutting-edge wine lists. The time to further explore, share information and celebrate volcanic wines has arrived.

BACKGROUND

• The International Volcanic Wine Conference (IVWC), is a first-of-its-kind, full-day educational program for wine industry professionals and media. The conference will feature participating regions from around the world with soils derived entirely, or partially, from volcanic parent material, and the exceptional wines produced by wineries within them. This 1st annual conference will take place in New York, the largest and most influential wine market in the US, and will consist of a series of innovative presentations, workshop discussions, and tastings for trade and media.



MISSION

- The IVWC aims to establish a *Volcanic Wine Movement*, and to provide educational and promotional opportunities for volcanic wine producers internationally.
- The IVWC will act as the catalyst and facilitator to eventually bring together all of the world's volcanic regions and create a "Volcanic Wine Brand," defined as a unique category of wines produced under some of the most extreme viticultural conditions on the planet.
- The IVWC will also help establish the volcanic wine brand as a premium category of high quality wines with a true sense of place, thereby increasing their perceived value and enabling higher price points.



OBJECTIVES

- Establish an industry-leading, must-attend conference promoting volcanic wines, with the following aims:
 - ✓ Take a leading role in defining the volcanic wine category.
 - ✓ Develop innovative ways to present the wines to trade and consumers
 - ✓ Create a market niche for volcanic wines with an image of uniqueness and high quality
 - ✓ Create consumer and trade demand for volcanic wines
 - ✓ Help increase the value of volcanic wines
 - ✓ Facilitate the availability of volcanic wines and increase distribution by helping wineries open new markets through the IVWC organizers' vast network of US and Canada-based importers/distributors

In addition to being a partner and principle critic for WineAlign.com, he writes regularly for publications such as Wine & Spirits Magazine, freelances widely, and consults on restaurant beverage programs from small neighborhood operations to national chains. During the last 15 years, John has developed and presented hundreds of educational seminars and master classes for a dozens of trade organizations, including Wines from Santorini, Napa Valley Vintners, Sonoma County Vintners, Wines of Chile, Wine Australia, Austrian Wine Marketing Board, Wines of Hungary, and Islas Canarias, among many others.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

To qualify for participation in the IVWC, a region or individual producer must have 1/3 acreage under vine to produce wine from grapes grown in soils derived from parent volcanic material, or containing a high proportion of volcanic ash and other tephra/pyroclastic material. Neither the entire region, nor an entire producer's portfolio need be volcanic, though only volcanic wines with 1/3 acreage of Volcanic above will be permitted at the IVWC. 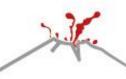
